AQHA ENTRY FEES:

All Day Fees are \$70/judge to show all AQHA classes, all divisions. All Day Fee does not include \$6/judge AQHA drug fee or NSBA class fees.

Open, Amateur, & Select Amateur classes are \$17 per class/per judge.

L1 Amateur & L1 Youth classes, including all Walk-Trot are \$15 per class/per judge.

NON-AQHA CLASS FEES:

NSBA classes are \$10 per class/per judge.

PGS Leadline —FREE!

AQHA DRUG FEE:

AQHA requires that all horses entered in the show pay a \$6.00 drug testing fee Per Judge.

TRAIL & FENCE CLASS FEES:

For Trail classes, there will be a one-time trail obstacle and warmup fee of \$10 per horse for the circuit.

For Fence classes, there will be a one-time fence warmup fee of \$20 per horse for the circuit.

CATTLE FEES—*NEW FEE STRUCTURE*:

Cattle fees are \$65 if reserved by July 20, 2019.

Please reserve your cattle in writing via text or email to PGSQHA@gmail.com by July 20 to avoid a \$50 late fee. Include full name, horse's show name, & number of cattle for each day with your reservation.

Cattle reservations must be cancelled in writing at least 24 hours in advance before start of cattle classes. Otherwise, individual reserving cattle will still be billed for cattle fee.

STALLS, RV, & GROUNDS FEES:

Stalls are \$30/night. See stall form to reserve.

Stalls & RV spaces can be reserved upon arrival.

Grounds fee for non-stalled horses is \$15/show day. Shavings may be purchased in the stall office for \$11/bag.

Prizes

All-Around prizes will be awarded for each Division. All Around will follow AQHA rule 803.5 eligibility in that you must compete in at least 3 categories for your selected division, as defined by AQHA. **You MUST show in your respective division Halter class to qualify for All-Around awards.**


Circuit awards will be awarded for each AQHA class. Must show to all applicable judges.

Ribbons will be available for class winners 1st-6th place.


AQHA, NSBA, & PGSQHA APPROVED SHOW:

All entries in this show are subject to the rules and regulations set up by the AQHA whether or not they are specifically referred to in this brochure. All exhibitors will have to present registration papers for AQHA & NSBA classes. In youth and amateur classes, the horse must be registered in the name of the contestant or a member of the immediate family. Youth & Amateur contestants must have current AQHA cards. An original owner's copy of a Negative Coggins test within the last 12 months is required to enter the grounds.

- 3) **English** to include Equitation, Hunter Under Saddle, all over fences classes, Driving (and Walk-Trots)
- 4) **Ranch** to include Reining, all Ranch classes, all cattle classes
- 5) **Speed** to include Barrels, Poles, & Stakes

The Fine Print:

- Points to be credited to the Horse for all exhibitors including Youth, Amateur, Select, & Open at all Levels (L1,L2 & L3) per standard 9 point scale. Excludes lead line.
- To compete in a category, the horse must show in at least one class in that category at BOTH shows.
